#### Beach Recovery What would you do?

Picture the scene: you are driving along the beach between Beachport and Carpenters Rocks and you come across an old Range Rover buried up to the axels in nice soft sand, below the high water mark with, of course, an incoming tide. A quick survey of the situation revealed that the driver and passenger were trying to get themselves out of their predicament. But will they beat the incoming tide?




