



Trip Reports

PEAKE - 13th & 14th August 2011

After availing ourselves of breakfast and coffee at the Tailem Bend Roadhouse, 6 vehicles from the

Gawler and Districts Club and the Wanderers Club headed off on a cool Saturday morning for a social weekend at Peake. For those of you who have been along the road from Tailem Bend towards Peake recently, you might be "saddened" to learn that the "marker dunnies" have gone (yes, there were 4 earlier this year).

Camp set-up was a leisurely affair with morning tea being grabbed before we all gathered around the campfire spot for a short briefing on the weekend plans. The common agreement was that social weekends were for fun and fellowship; no pressure and no deadlines. With 8 vehicles ready for some driving, we split into two groups and headed in opposite directions.



The morning's drive was a very sedate affair that provided all an opportunity to become familiar with the general environment at Peake.
