

Geocaching – What is it?

The Groundspeak Geocaching Logo is a trademark of Groundspeak Inc. Much of the information below was obtained from the Geocaching website www.geocaching.com

Geocaching can be considered Treasure Hunting in the 21st Century. A Cache (or "treasure chest") is hidden anywhere out and about, and its Global Positioning System (GPS) coordinates are recorded. With these coordinates, someone else can come along to try and find the Cache.

Geocaching can be played by anyone, and the caches can be located anywhere on Earth. There is no fee to participate. All you need is a personal GPS unit and a sense of adventure. Just don't forget to take something to put back into the Cache.

History – When the GPS signal degradation (called Selective Availability) was removed by the Clinton administration May 1st 2000, it opened up the possibility of games like this one.

On May 3rd, a container of goodies was hidden by someone outside of Portland, Oregon – in celebration of the removing of Selective Availability. By May 6th, the cache was visited twice, and logged in the logbook once.

Mike Teague was the first to find the container, and built the first website to document these containers and their locations.

In July 2000, Jeremy Irish found Mike Teague's website and found his first cache outside of Seattle, Washington. Recognising the potential of the game (but never expected the growth), Jeremy approached Mike Teague with a new site design, used the name Geocaching, and developed a new website adding virtual logs, maps, and a way to make it easier to maintain caches as the sport grows. The site was alive for a while, but the official torch was passed to Jeremy on September 6th.

Since the launch of the website, the Geocaching sport has grown to caches in all 50 States of the USA and over 100 other countries, including Australia. There are now many variations of the game, including virtual caches, offset caches, puzzle caches, and multi-stage caches. New ideas and new great games crop up every day.

The official website for Geocaching is **www.geocaching.com** and anyone can access the site and join Geocaching.

Several members of our Club have become interested in the game, and the person who initiated interest in it in South Australia (Alex McGregor of Carto Graphics, Unley) has been invited to address the Club as guest speaker at our May meeting. He will also discuss some other GPS and navigational topics.

Following this, a combined Mystery Drive and Geocaching event will be organised, and members can elect which event they would like to participate in for the day. We will meet at a common location in the afternoon for a combined barbecue, and those who take part can camp overnight if they wish.
