ORGANISING A TRIP

It's Simple

- 1. Decide on a destination
- 2. Consult the trips' coordinator
- 3. Set a, date, time to start and duration
- 4. What is the purpose -training, towing, walking, touring?
- 5. Consider the accommodation needs: camping, cabins, caravan park, bush camping
- 6. Degree of difficulty -do participants need some minimum level of training?


- 7. Determine what equipment is needed.
- 8. Check which maps are needed, and the route to be followed.
- 9. Check accessibility of the roads and organise access where necessary.
- 10. Put in a trip sheet.
- 11. Consider communications and safety for more remote trips.
- 12. Have personal contact information for all participants on remote trips.



Tip of the Month

Keep Clean Using Minimal Water

When on extended travel, one of the critical items is water. Did you know that the humble garden pump spray bottle makes a very efficient "ablution system". Here is the trick; head off to your local hardware store and pick up 1 x 2 litre and 2 x 1 litre pump sprayers. These should cost you less than \$5 each. Fill the 2 litre bottle with water. Fill one of the small bottles with liquid soap (diluted about 25% soap, 75% water – could be 33% / 66%) and the other with diluted disinfectant – Detol is the best, but, of course, the most expensive.

Pump each bottle up and keep handy. The disinfectant is very good for sanitising the hands after a trip to the scrub with a shovel. The soap get the hand clean of all sorts of camp grubbiness and the water rinses both off. Once you get used to the system, you should be using less that a litre of water per day for all of your washing needs. There is nothing better than having a "shower" first thing in the morning from the cool water – you won't need much whatever the time of year.

PS. If you keep the bottles in the car, remember to de-pressurise them before your hit the rough track – 1 litre of diluted disinfectant goes a very long way!

Peter and Darryl have been busy with the handover from Sue, and continuing with the same successful formula planning their first Interclub Working Bee.

Camping: Camper trailers and caravans can be accommodated It has one very good long drop but you need to bring everything else (water, food, shelter)

Please note that 16th -18th March will still be in fireban time so the "camp fire" will need to be artificial (Gas Stove will be OK unless Total Fire Ban in place)

Equipment to bring:

Box Trailers: some would be useful (we have a few tonnes of materials to move)

Tools - post hole digging tools, pruners, loppers, bow saw, handsaw, crowbar, shovel, rake, hand tools, etc.

Personal - working gloves, good footwear, drinking water, sun protection (hat, long sleeves, long pants, sun screen). Bring high visibility vests or clothing and possibly share them with your fellow workers.

Less Border Track Damage

Recently Peter and Darryl met Rebecca Pudney Senior Ranger Dept. of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) at Ngarkat.

They reviewed the various tracks and noted that the one way section of the Border Track was in very good condition after its year of use. However 30 sites were recognised where useful remediation work could be done in the 2012 working bee.

Activities will include:

- Repairs to existing wire and poly pipe barriers
- Construction of new barriers
- Filling selected track sections with gravel
- Trimming overgrowing shrubs
