





4WD DRIVERS UPSET AT PERMIT CHANGE ON CANNING STOCK ROUTE

From 30 September 2012 the Australian National Four Wheel Drive Council (4 Wheel Drive Australia), will no longer issue travel permits for the Canning Stock Route (CSR), one of Australia's iconic and most challenging four wheel drive route.

"In future travellers will need to apply for permits through Kuju Wangka which represents native title areas along the CSR," said Council President Eric Morey.

The Council regrets the change which ends a successful collaboration with the Western Desert Lands Aboriginal Corporation.

Since 2007 the Council has helped the Martu people with a permit system to help manage access across their traditional lands. Permit funds were originally targeted for community improvements and potentially to employ Indigenous rangers responsible for preserving significant areas while educating travellers.

"We are disappointed with Kuju Wangka's change and think permit fees could rise in future."

"We are concerned the new managers have ignored our efforts to develop culturally sensitive information about travelling the CSR and co-opted our materials without acknowledgement."

The CSR is a major tourist attraction for all Australian citizens. In recent times many four wheel drive clubs and other groups have put a lot of effort into preserving significant areas and facilities along the CSR.

"We hope they are not treated in a similarly dismissive manner."

Mr Morey said that in the past five years the Council has returned more than \$56,000 in CSR permit fees to Native Title Holders but received no feedback on how the money was spent.

The not for profit Council represents incorporated four wheel drive clubs throughout Australia. It covered the costs of developing and managing the CSR permit system and provided an around the clock online service for travellers including after-hours contacts.

4WDSA – NRAU – BTC – Banksia Seed Distribution

Recently, 3 members of our club and a guest, took part in a “Banksia Seed Distribution” weekend at Ngarkat Conservation Park. We are probably all familiar with the Banksia flowers, but how many know what the actual seeds look like? As is common with many native Australian plants, the Banksia requires the heat of a fire to release the delicate seeds from the very hard woody fruit (aka ‘candle’).

As heat is applied to the cone, the ‘cases’ open and allow the seed to be released. In the picture above, the seed is the light brown part which is about 5mm long.

We soon had a decent fire going thanks to the ready supply of firewood provided by the property owner. Now it was time to learn the cooking process. Essentially, the ‘cones’ need to be heated sufficiently to open the seed cases. This is a balance between amounts of heat over amount of time. I’m sure there is a science here, but we were relying on trial and error. Anyway, after about 4 hours work, 3 volunteers had burnt about half of the seed cones and filled 1 and a half 20l buckets with seed. Good days work, so time for happy hour!

Saturday saw the early starters meeting with the rest of the volunteers to head to Ngarkat and spread some seed. The plan was to spread seed in revegetation / closed areas from previous working bees. As well as the seed burnt on Friday, we had seed from 2003 (an experiment into life of ‘burnt’ seed) and some buckets of ash collected after fire then rain that might also contain naturally viable seed. It is surprising how quickly 2 buckets of seed can be distributed – took less than 2 hours to sew the seed we had available! The rest of Saturday was spent travelling south down the Border Track and accompanying a vehicle with a damaged front wheel. Was a long trip back to camp, but all arrived safely, even if Happy Hours was very brief.

On Saturday evening, we had the pleasure of joining the property owner and some of their friends around a pretty good “camp fire”.

Sunday was originally planned to be a “burn and distribute” seed day but, we spent most of the day recovering the seed from the remaining 18 buckets. Good thing is that we now have enough information to be able to share with the rest of the world on the most efficient method of recovering Banksia seed.

A full report will appear in a future 4WD Matters. But, in the mean time, my personal thanks to Martin, Martin, and George for their help over the weekend.

Fight the Bite

A health warning from SA Health

The recent warm weather and rains in the Northern Territory and in Northern South Australia has seen an increase in mosquito numbers across central Australia.

Mosquitoes are not only a nuisance but some can spread serious disease such as Ross River virus (RRv) and Barmah Forest virus (BFv) when they bite.



(Symptoms of RRv and BFv can include joint pains, rash, fever, fatigue or muscle pain)

There is **NO CURE** and **NO VACCINE** to protect against these mosquito borne diseases. The only known and effective way to reduce risk of mosquito borne disease is to prevent mosquito bites.


If you are a visitor, or if you live in northern South Australia, it is important that you protect yourself, your family and friends against mosquito borne disease by *Fighting the Bite*.

Key strategies include:

- **Covering Up** – wear long, light coloured, loose fitting clothing (mosquitoes can bite through tight clothes like jeans)
- **Apply personal insect repellent containing DEET or Picaridin** (avoid using on babies and toddlers and ALWAYS read and follow instructions on the label first).
- Ensure **insect screens cover openings** in holiday houses, boats, caravans or tents.
- Cover sleeping areas or beds with **mosquito nets** if necessary.
